The tabletop is veneered and embellished with a finely gouged owl's beak molding, which lends elegance and definition to the piece's profile. The legs, with their distinctive lyre-shaped curve, are embellished with a central coat of arms adorned with clusters of fruit and lateral scrolls--details that reflect the artisanal craftsmanship of the era. The crossbar connecting the legs features a leaf-motif carving and scrollwork, with a central coat of arms bearing the letters "MP." This table is a perfect example of the Neo-Renaissance style, where attention to detail and the quality of the materials combine to create a piece of furniture with great visual impact.
