Lalique, Single-flower vase in frosted clear crystal, Marie-Claude model Vase with a tall, narrow neck in frosted clear crystal. Its fluted body, alternating between transparent and frosted crystal, is adorned with decorative oval motifs that are striated and engraved. This type of vase was first created in 1965 by Marie-Claude Lalique (1935-2003), granddaughter of René Lalique (1860-1945) and daughter of Marc Lalique (1900-1977).
