A hand-blown amber glass vase with a long cylindrical neck and a globular body, resting on three small glass feet, decorated with a polychrome enamel design featuring chevron motifs accented with black beads, floral scrolls in blue, pink, and turquoise on a colored enamel background. This type of enamel decoration on amber glass is characteristic of the great tradition of Bohemian glassworks from the late 19th and early 20th centuries, renowned for their Oriental-inspired designs executed with great finesse.
