Art Nouveau was an artistic movement of the late 19th and early 20th centuries that primarily dominated architecture and the decorative arts. It is characterized by the 'whip-like' line and draws its inspiration primarily from nature. Born as a reaction against the excesses of industrialization and the stifling reproduction of old styles, this movement spread internationally. In order to renew the artistic vocabulary, other sources of inspiration were sought. Thus, beginning in the 1860s, Japanese art became a major source of inspiration for artists, particularly in France. "*"
