Description

Oil on panel. Hand-signed "M. Salbah." In this striking mid-20th-century Moroccan painting, the paint itself seems to exude the earthen heat of the kasbah, trapped within a network of labyrinthine alleyways that intertwine like a living organism. The artist's vision, imbued with a visceral intuition of the Maghreb landscape, dissolves the centuries-old architecture into an aromatic potion where masses of color explode with the raw ferocity of Fauvism: bluish doors glistening in the sun, coppery shadows, and a blazing vermillion that vibrates on the surface. Through this feverish geometric network glide its inhabitants--mysterious figures draped in robes--whose Impressionist brushstrokes almost allow one to feel the density of the atmosphere, an intoxicating blend of cumin, orange blossom,

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and tea smoke.
