Extremely popular among French artisans from the 19th through the early 20th century, this cauldron is a true masterpiece of copper craftsmanship from the Art Nouveau period, when fluid lines inspired by nature dominated design. The entire body is adorned with voluptuous, organic floral motifs in bas-relief, and its handles mimic the flowing lines of grapevine branches. It is incredibly charming, perfect for a collection of folk art objects with an Art Nouveau theme! Over 130 years old, it has
