A large and beautiful Orientalist watercolor depicting a vast and luminous landscape of the Maghreb, likely located in Algeria or Morocco... The work is signed in the lower right corner by Henri Clamens(1905-1937), an outstanding painter listed in the Bénézit, whose biography can be found on Wikipedia: a native in Nîmes, he was poised for a bright artistic future, but in 1937 he died prematurely at the age of 32...Henri Clamens had won a silver medal at the 1926 Salon des Artistes Français, and became a resident of the prestigious Villa Abd-el-Tif in Algiers, winning the prize there in 1930. Note: Henri Clamens died at the Esaltes Sanatorium in 1937... His paintings and gouaches were painted primarily in Algeria and Morocco ...the French art historian Jean Alazard said of him: " Henri Clamens's

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all-too-brief life is an example that deserves our reflection.
