A 32-piece tableware set made of fine Terre de Fer earthenware, from the famous HB & Cie Choisy-le-Roi factory. This is the "Louis XIII" model, produced in the late 19th century (1880-1900). This model is distinguished by its refined two-tone decoration: a scalloped border featuring friezes of vine leaves printed in pale blue, framing lively, captioned landscape scenes in the center rendered in sepia (bister). Each type of plate features a different rural or seascape scene: The Pier, The Dovecote, The Boat, Evening, Snow, The Turret, The Belvedere Lot Composition (32 pieces) 26 dinner plates (Diameter: 24 cm) 5 soup plates (Diameter: 24 cm) 1 large round serving platter (Diameter: 34 cm) Condition: Generally in good household condition. sorting: pieces with major defects (significant cracks or chips) have been removed. Please note that, consistent with the age and use of this fine earthenware, there are localized discolorations and age spots (mostly on the reverse side).
