This unique, egg-shaped vase features a stylized, naturalistic polychrome design depicting flowers and leaves from East Indian cherry trees. The yellow flowers and deep teal foliage stand out vividly against a light blue background with a glossy crackled glaze. Charles Catteau (1880-1966) was a Franco-Belgian Art Deco industrial designer and master ceramist whose influence was exceptional. He gained international renown primarily during his tenure as artistic director at the renowned Belgian ceramics manufacturer Boch Frères Keramis, in La Louvière, where he worked from 1920 until the early 1940s. Catteau is famous for making high-quality art accessible to the general public by introducing vibrant colors, stylized flora and
