Carved and giltwood salon suite. France, 19th century. Settee 140 x 65 x h 107 cm. Chairs 55 x 55 x h 94 cm. A suite comprising a settee and a pair of side chairs, entirely carved and gilded. The cresting of the settee and the top rails of the chairs are decorated with pierced shell and foliate motifs, echoed in the front frieze and the arm supports. The shaped legs, in eighteenth-century taste, show a later addition of metal casters. The upholstery, in pure Rubelli silk from Venice with a dotted pattern, complements the carved frame and enhances the overall elegance of the set. Condition report: Overall good condition.
