Elegant Restoration-period dressing table, dating from the first half of the 19th century, circa 1820-1830, crafted from mahogany and mahogany veneer. This piece features a particularly elegant front, showcasing a beautiful selection of veneers with dynamic grain patterns, arranged symmetrically across the two doors. The top rail also displays a remarkable wood grain pattern, characteristic of the taste of the Restoration period. The hinged top panel reveals a large, lined and organized dressing compartment. In the lower section, the two doors open to a cleverly organized interior, featuring two small side drawers as well as several compartments and storage spaces. The simplicity of its design, accentuated by rounded moldings, contrasts

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pleasantly with the natural richness of the mahogany. The piece rests on small turned legs at the front. A rare dressing table, both decorative and functional, retaining all the charm of French Restoration-era furniture.
