REV25COQ001A charming little solid silver rooster, crafted in openwork filigree, particularly on the wings and tail. The bird is depicted in a striking pose, with its crest raised, well-defined legs, and plumage rendered with great delicacy. The body and wings feature filigree work typical of high-quality 19th-century Russian craftsmanship. Master's mark on a rectangular plate, legible as CS / C.S., corresponding to Carl Siewers (???? ??????), a silversmith based in Saint Petersburg (active from 1844, with his own workshop from 1849, known until the 1860s). Weight: 16 grams of solid silver Dimensions: approximately 6 x 4.5 x 3 cm A very lovely example of a small Russian filigree
