



Hunting Trophy, Hare And Partridge, Single-wood Panel, Black Forest (?) 19th Century

Description

Hunting trophy, specifically from a forest hunt, featuring a partridge and a hare in bas-relief, both suspended upside down on a single-piece wooden panel with a dark patina. The entire piece is mounted and secured to a plywood panel covered with 20th-century green fabric. It has a hanging hook on the back. France or the Black Forest, 19th century--more likely from the early part of the century than the late part, or even predating the 19th century. As I am not a specialist but rather a generalist, I deliberately wish to remain noncommittal regarding the dating, as I do not wish to assign a date that might later prove inaccurate. I'm basing this on the stylized depiction of these animals and the patina of the wood, which seems to correspond well to early 19th-century work. In very good overall condition,
