Description

Alex de Andreis (1871-1939) - Musketeer - Oil on mahogany panel under glass A beautiful and interesting painting by Alex de Andreis (1871-1939), a Belgian painter, known in particular for his genre scenes and figures in historical costumes. This oil on mahogany panel depicts an elegant musketeer or gentleman in 17th-century costume, shown full-length in an interior setting. The figure, wearing a wide black hat and an imposing white ruff, is dressed in a rich green doublet, dark breeches, and ornate shoes. He holds a slender sword in his hand. The composition is particularly captivating due to the finesse of the drawing and the quality of the detailed execution. Alex de Andreis pays special attention to the rendering of the fabrics, accessories, and costume. The character's

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expressive face stands out harmoniously against an interior of deep tones, enlivened by a large red curtain. This depiction of a gentleman in period costume is highly characteristic of Alex de Andreis's artistic world, as he had a particular fondness for historicist scenes and characters inspired by the 17th and 18th centuries. The work bears the signature "Alex de Andreis" in the lower right corner. It is presented in a beautiful antique frame made of wood and gilded stucco, richly adorned with foliage, flowers, scrollwork, and relief motifs.
