Description

Oil painting on wood by Ettore Cumbo (also known as Ettore Cumbo Borgia), a painter and landscape artist born in Messina in 1833 and who died in Florence in 1899. Style and period: Initially trained in engineering, he later devoted himself to landscape painting, becoming particularly associated with the Florentine Impressionist period and forging ties with the Tuscan artistic community of the 19th century. The painting, set in a blind gilded wooden frame, is an oil on canvas work from 1872 depicting a landscape view of Rome with classical ruins, likely an ancient Roman aqueduct or an archaeological site in the countryside.
