Green glass vase decorated with hand-painted enamel floral motifs depicting chrysanthemums in shades of white, yellow, pink, and brown with gilded foliage accents. Features a baluster body with a thick rolled rim. France. Legras Montgeoye. Art Nouveau period. Late 19th / early 20th century. Height: 14.5 cm / Rim diameter: 10 cm / Base diameter: 7.5 cm Good condition. During the late 19th and early 20th centuries, Art Nouveau glassmakers across Europe popularized enamel-decorated colored glass featuring Japanese-inspired botanical motifs, such as chrysanthemums. Production of similar enameled green glass wares was common among French glassworks (such as Legras or Montjoye) and Bohemian manufacturers.
