Pair of footed crystal dish (tazza or comport) featuring fine diamond-point geometric cut crystal. The shallow basin is finished with a gadrooned gilt bronze (ormolu) rim and rests on a faceted stem with a circular foot rimmed in gilt bronze. France. BACCARAT. Charles X / Restauration period (Circa 1820-1830). Very good condition. During the Charles X period, French glassworks like Baccarat, Saint-Louis, and Montcenis produced exquisite cut crystal table centerpieces. Combining brilliant diamond-point cutting with finely chased gilt bronze mounts showcased the technical mastery of early 19th-century French lapidaries and bronze casters.
