This 15-volume edition is the most comprehensive version of his dictionary. The set shows signs of wear, scuffing, and chipping on the bindings, wear on the caps and corners, partially faded gilding, and some damage to the title labels and volume number labels. Some pages have scattered foxing and stains. The pages and quires remain firmly bound within the volumes, with the exception of the first leaf of Volume 1, which is fragile, as shown in the photo.
