Sarreguemines, two octagonal yellow-mass plates. 1 - An "archaic" plate made of fine earthenware, octagonal in shape with a yellow mass, depicting a group of children playing soldiers in the center. "Advance at the rallying cry," the password to enter the camp. Decor applied using transfer printing. Plate without a foot rim, without wing decoration. Engraved mark: Sarguemines, the old spelling of the town's name; the first mark bearing the town's name used by the factory. Diameter: 18 cm. Good condition. Circa 1830. 2 - So-called "archaic" plate made of fine earthenware, octagonal in shape with a yellow mass, depicting the Auberge de Matten in Switzerland in the center. Decor applied by transfer printing. Plate without a foot rim, without wing decoration. Intaglio mark (to be
