Description

Stoneware vase with a flamed glazed decoration and slight crystallization with an incised signature on the reverse from the workshops of Alexandre Bigot in Mer Late 19th or early 20th century Alexandre Bigot is one of the great names of Art Nouveau and notably collaborated with Guimard, Bourdelle, Lavriotte, and--according to some--Rodin; he is also known for having supplied the stoneware for the Villa Majorelle in Nancy Baluster vase with a tapered, garlic-bulb-shaped neck and two flanged handles, glazed once in a warm brown, then decorated with brown drips on a beige background 26 cm tall, in good condition Questions are welcome Documentation Paul Arthur Franch Art Nouveau Ceramics Hélène Bédague Alexandre Bigot Chimiste et Céramiste
