Bronze maternity statue by Tikar
Bronze statue depicting a mother and her child, originating from the Grassfields region of Cameroon. It is crafted using the lost-wax casting technique, which means that each piece is completely unique, as the clay shell must be broken to reveal the final sculpture cast in a bronze alloy. These figures often depict a queen or a woman of noble lineage seated on a royal stool, holding a child in her arms, in a posture symbolizing motherhood. It is characterized by highly stylized, bulging eyes, an open mouth revealing her teeth, and openwork ears with distinctive geometric shapes, typical of the metalwork of Cameroon's Grassfields. Complex scarification marks cover the pregnant woman's rounded belly, symbolizing beauty, fertility, and social status. Bronze with a
