Description

The antique paintings, floral still life, Jeté de roses category presents an 19th-century oil painting on canvas. French antiquity.

The composition depicts an elegant French School floral still life, featuring a rich group of red, white and yellow roses, accompanied by green leaves and small buds that are still closed.

The work is signed lower left "J. Poy" and can be attributed to the French painter Jean-Marie Poy (1843-1914).

The composition is set against a dark, neutral background, from which the colours of the flowers emerge with particular intensity.

The contrast between the deep red of the roses, the creamy white and yellow of the large central rose, and the various shades

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of green in the leaves creates a refined effect of depth and luminosity.

The painting is an excellent example of 19th-century French floral painting and is of particular interest to collectors of French antique paintings, floral still lifes, 19th-century French painting and period decorative artworks.

The painting is enhanced by a beautiful contemporary gilded frame finished with fine gold leaf, which further increases its prestige and decorative appeal.

The frame and the oil painting have been professionally and carefully restored.
