Made in France. 950/1000 silver, Minerva hallmark. Silversmith's mark: Georges Fouquet-Lapar, circa 1900. Length: 19.8 cm. Scoop: approximately 7.1 × 4.6 cm. Weight: 100 g. Very good condition, with no dents or distortions.
