This piece of furniture is a revolving bookcase (often called a revolving bookcase in the English style), a type of furniture that was very popular in the late 19th and early 20th centuries for optimizing book storage in offices and living rooms. Furniture Details Period / Style: Late 19th century or early 20th century (late Victorian or Edwardian period, circa 1890-1920). Structure: A design with three storage levels mounted on a central pivoting axis. It features openwork vertical slats or posts to hold the books in place while keeping them visible from all four sides. Material: Solid natural wood (likely oak or walnut, based on the visible grain on the shelves). Appearance: The wood has a rough, authentic patina, with some signs of wear and traces of drying that attest to its age. The lower
