This piece of furniture is a Louis XIII-style writing desk or side table, a classic of French regional rustic furniture, inspired by models from the "Haute Époque" (17th century) and the 18th century. Shape & Structure: The tabletop is octagonal or rectangular with cut corners (beveled edges). It features a single drawer along the base, fitted with an antique drop-down wrought-iron handle. Base: The four legs are beautifully turned into balusters. They are connected by a sturdy, low, H-shaped crossbar--a typical feature of the Louis XIII period designed to stabilize the structure. Material: Solid wood, likely walnut, with a warm patina. This type of side table or small rustic desk is highly sought after for charming interiors in the country chic or wabi-sabi styles.
