Henri Rivière (1864-1951) was a French painter, engraver, and illustrator. He began his career in drawing, then moved on to intaglio engraving--specifically etching--in 1882. At the same time, in 1886, he embarked on a career as a director and set designer for shadow theater performances at the Cabaret du Chat Noir, enhancing these shows with the creation of highly innovative, colorful sets. He then devoted himself
