Description

A lovely little table that doubles as a desk, made of solid walnut and oak, dating from the 18th century. It rests on four turned baluster legs connected by an H-shaped crossbar. The crossbar shows some signs of wear due to its age (see photos). Our table features a small under-top drawer at the front, likely added in the 1900s for use as a desk. The tabletop is made of oak and is beautifully molded around its entire perimeter. It was also likely refitted around the same time as the drawer (around 1900), as were the finials at the ends of the legs. This piece is in good overall condition; it shows some old signs of woodworm damage and some wear and tear due to its age and use.
