Small Paris porcelain jar from the last quarter of the 18th century stamped on the reverse in red stencil with a crowned "A" Manufactured on Rue Thiroux, founded by André Marie Leboeuf in 1776 Under the patronage of Queen Marie Antoinette beginning 1778 Decorated with delicate garlands of flowers tied with a ribbon, double gold border Good condition; slight wear on the gilding I have not been able to determine the use of this object--which is evidently quite rare given its size and shape--nor whether it had a lid or not.
