RARE PERSIAN RUG; STARTING IN THE 16th CENTURY, PERSIAN RUGS WERE MADE OF WOOL, COTTON, AND SILK THE RUG HAS FIRST SERVED A PRACTICAL PURPOSE IN THE EAST FROM THE VERY BEGINNING BEFORE EVOLVING INTO AN ART FORM IN ITS OWN RIGHT. SYMBOLIC REPRESENTATIONS CAN BE FOUND IN THE MOTIFS CREATED BY DESIGNERS SUCH AS THE TREE OF LIFE, SYMBOLIZING FERTILITY, CONTINUITY, SERVING AS A LINK BETWEEN THE UNDERWORLD, THE EARTH, AND THE DIVINE, THE CENTRAL FIELD OF THE RUG, SURROUNDED BY A DOUBLE BORDER, FEATURES A MOTIF OF
