Overhanging cornice. Inside, there are 4 shelves, ideal for storing books or other items. In good overall condition. The end of the cornice is beveled. The baseboard appears to have been redone in the early 20th century. Late 18th-century Regency style. This piece of furniture is entirely disassembled using dowels; it will be disassembled for delivery.
