Pair of Imari porcelain plates, Japan, Meiji period, late 19th - early 20th century. An elegant pair of Japanese plates made of Imari porcelain, featuring the characteristic polychrome decoration in shades of cobalt blue, iron red, green, and gold accents. The center panel is adorned with a floral and botanical design, centered around a vase of flowers, while the rim is divided into sections richly decorated with flowers, foliage, and geometric motifs. Alternating red and blue panels with trellis motifs, giving the piece as a whole a particularly rhythmic and refined design. The border is scalloped, emphasizing the decorative quality of these pieces. The reverse features a blue underglaze painted design with stylized floral motifs. Produced in Japan by Arita / Imari, likely intended in part for the Western
