Description

Small Louis XV-period chest of drawers, or "sauteuse," stamped by Jean Nicolas Marchand, who was admitted as a master cabinetmaker in Paris around 1730-1735, and bearing the guild mark. Chest of drawers in violet wood veneer, decorated with rocaille-style bronze pull handles and feet. The chest is topped with a Saint-Edouard gray marble top. Chest of drawers restored in the workshop. Jean Nicolas Marchand was one of Louis XV's suppliers through Gilles Joubert, the King's cabinetmaker, and Gaudreaux, cabinetmaker for the Garde-Meuble de la Couronne.
