Description

Ancient Bronze Bhaisajyaguru Buddha, better known as the Medicine Buddha, sits in the full lotus position atop a two-tiered, ornate lotus throne. The stylized, rounded petals running along the base highlight the bronze structure with its thick patina. His tightly coiled hair tapers toward a prominent jewel forming a topknot on the crown of his head. His elongated earlobes symbolize his historical renunciation of rich and heavy jewelry. Bhaisajyaguru is recognizable by the small bowl of medicine he holds in his left hand, resting on his lap, and by the varada mudra--a gesture of generosity or healing--which he performs with his right hand. The complex, finely engraved floral and geometric motifs along the border of his monastic robe reflect traditional
