A regional cherrywood dish cabinet with a dish-drying rack and chestnut sides, dating from the late 18th century. The front features several levels for storing and displaying tableware, including two rows of compartments that serve as a plate rack. The central section opens via two drawers fitted with wooden knobs. The open lower section also provides storage for dishes or utensils. Beautiful traditional construction, with a back made of wide solid wood planks. Molded cornice at the top and a simple base resting on two feet. The piece has a lovely warm, natural patina that particularly highlights the cherry wood. In good overall condition, with normal signs of wear and use typical of an antique piece.
