Silver forks, France, 18th century. Set of four silver forks, "uniplat" style, three of which bear 18th-century hallmarks; one fork is unmarked, as the hallmarks have been erased. One pair: master silversmith Louis-Antoine Taillepied, Paris, circa 1762-1768. One fork: master silversmith Charles-François Lautran, Paris, circa 1762. 950/1000 silver, hallmarks of the City of Paris. Lengths: 19.5 cm, 19.3 cm, and 18.2 cm. Total weight: 315 g. Shows signs of use, but no deformation or impact damage.
