Description

Napoleon III side table with marquetry, bronze accents, and porcelain medallions depicting romantic scenes. A charming Napoleon III-era side table, crafted in the second half of the 19th century. Each medallion is framed by a chiseled bronze mount. The two drawers are fitted with finely

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chiseled bronze pulls, while the corners are adorned with beautiful bronze finials featuring foliage motifs. A marquetry crossbar adds elegance and stability to the piece. This table perfectly exemplifies the refinement of Napoleon III furniture, where cabinetmaking, marquetry, bronze, and porcelain combine to create a piece of exceptional decorative quality.
