Circa 1850-1870: a pair of panels carved in high relief from cork, with pulverized cork vegetation, depicting prestigious monuments (one of which is clearly identifiable as the Neue Palais in Potsdam); sky painted in watercolor; white embossed "Marie-Louise" frames and gilded Napoleon III frames--all characteristic of German productions for tourists traveling along the Rhine as part of the Grand Tour. Frame dimensions: 45 x 41.5 centimeters
