Description

19th-century Bohemian glass candy dish on a foot, engraved with roccaille and foliage motifs. The art of the table in Europe has always been at the heart of the arts. A true masterpiece of 19th-century glass craftsmanship in Germany or Austria, this candy dish stands out for its height, thanks to a pedestal that supports its bowl-shaped body, topped by a cap-shaped lid, with an inverted teardrop handle crowning the whole piece. Adorned with engraved motifs inspired by 19th-century Neoclassicism, scrollwork and roccaille patterns intermingle, marking the shift away from the styles of the Ancien Régime to make way for a freer artistic movement. Blue medallions with etched motifs are added. We see scenes from everyday life in the German countryside: the country house,
