Description

Episcopal gloves used during solemn ceremonies. Episcopal gloves are part of the traditional liturgical vestments. Their use gradually fell into disuse following the Second Vatican Council. Our pair is made of silk thread and richly adorned with embroidery in gold thread. These gloves belonged to Monsignor Ricard Fornesa i Puigdemassa (1883-1943), who served as vicar capitular of the Diocese of Urgell in Catalonia and, in that capacity, was co-prince of Andorra beginning in 1940. A historic and unique piece, particularly of interest to a collection dedicated to liturgical vestments or the religious history of Andorra and Catalonia. Proven provenance.
