A very elegant Napoleon III-era coffee table, made of rosewood veneer, featuring a remarkable scalloped-edge tabletop with rounded corners. The top is adorned in the center with a rich polychrome floral marquetry, composed of bouquets of flowers and foliage in golden and natural tones, accented by fine marquetry borders (in lemonwood) forming a geometric border. The rim, also richly decorated, features an extensive marquetry design of scrollwork and floral motifs, framed by reserved areas and fillets. The sides are embellished with small decorative panels. The table rests on an elegantly curved base, joined by an X-shaped crossbar and a central element adorned with a small decorative motif. The legs are curved and end in cleats, with elegant bronze fittings and ornaments. The piece as a whole
