Made of blown crystal, molded with scenes of monuments from the Rhenish Palatinate engraved with a wheel, this goblet is a true little "trophy" of travel, from a 19th-century Europe rediscovering itself, where the elite played at being adventurers. Here are each of the stops:-
Johannisberg: a wine-producing castle in the Rheingau, known for its Rieslings.- Godesberg: a fortress and spa town near Bonn.- Salzenburg: a spa town and castle on the Rhine.- Rolandseck: romantic castle in ruins, beloved by 19th-century poets and painters.- Kammerstein (probably Kammerburg): feudal ruin linked to the legend of the Lorelei.- Nonnenwerth: an island on the Rhine with a Benedictine convent.- Rheinfels: a
