Description

This work is a vibrant watercolor and gouache painting that captures the effervescent atmosphere of Rue Saint-Lazare at night in 1934. The artist uses quick, fluid brushstrokes to suggest the movement of passersby and the first automobiles (black taxis). The Haussmann-style buildings are painted sparingly, emphasizing light and atmosphere rather than architectural detail. The tones are warm (ochre, yellows) with touches of blue and green, characteristic of the work of Boris Pastoukhoff, whose Russian Post-Impressionist style flourished in Paris. A signature is visible in the lower right corner.
