Description

Oil on panel depicting a scene from the Gospel according to John, in which Jesus meets the Samaritan woman at Jacob's well. This work, which is of some artistic interest, can likely be attributed--based on its composition and the characterization of the figures--to the Roman Cortonian school of the mid-17th century; thus, it is possible to suggest a certain affinity with Pietro da Cortona's principal pupil, Ciro Ferri. The painting is of high quality, with the figures in the foreground--set against Jacob's well, which is placed at the center of the composition--rendered in balanced proportions, while a large, ruined classical column looms slightly behind them. The landscape, which opens up toward the horizon, leads to a distant city with a fairy-tale quality. The frame in which the panel is mounted is
