It reveals an interior fitted with several shelves, offering ample storage space. The lower section opens with two side drawers and two doors, also fitted with shelves inside. The fronts display beautiful cabinetry work that highlights the varying shades of mahogany and rosewood, arranged in a curly pattern and accentuated by molded frames. The piece is particularly remarkable for its large

The heavily molded cornice and fluted side panels further accentuate the verticality and grandeur of the piece.
