The figure stands out against a beige, patinated background, enlivened on the left by a prominent dark drapery that accentuates the contrast and depth of the composition. The color palette, now subtly muted by the passage of time, combines shades of ochre, brown, cream, red, and blue. This work attests to the craftsmanship of the 18th-century Brussels
