Rare Empire-period clock with a rotating circle depicting Chronos discovering time. The globe represents 24:00, and the serpent biting its own tail--known as Ouroboros--is a very ancient symbol dating back to the 16th century BCE and originating in the 18th Egyptian Dynasty. The serpent biting its own tail naturally symbolizes the cycle of time and eternity. The movement and mechanism are of the highest quality and of great complexity. This clock weighs 50 kg ! The clock is in its current condition; the Sienna yellow marble base has been restored, and the mechanism needs to be cleaned by a clockmaker. Top quality clock !
