Rare four-legged "Massue" stool by Charlotte Perriand, France, 1960s. Usually made with three legs, this unique version was custom-made at a client's request. Its thick, circular seat rests on four slightly flared cylindrical legs, giving the piece great stability. The wood's grain, highlighted by its original honey-colored patina, lends it a warm and natural character. Understated and sturdy, this stool exemplifies the utilitarian and sincere aesthetic of mountain furniture and the modernist interiors of the era. Shows signs of use and a beautiful patina of age.
