APPETIZERSERVING SET In their beautiful original case with a prestigious address, rare serving pieces for hors d'oeuvres and foie gras, crafted from solid silver and shaped to resemble gardening tools. The pieces, which are very heavy, are entirely engraved and chased with leaves and cherry fruits; the reverse of the upper sections is plain. A rare and luxurious set in excellent condition. The silversmiths' hallmark and the Minerve hallmark (950/1000) are engraved on each of the two pieces. Master silversmith: Labat & Pugibet (L&P, a shoemaker's awl.) 43 Rue de Montmorency, then 84 Rue Quincampoix in Paris for the House A. DELAMARE at 146 Palais-Royal in Paris, Engraved in 1877, crossed out in 1897. Their workshops were located in Paris, successively at 43, rue de Montmorency, then at
