A large scribal chest made of natural walnut and cherry wood (probably); this piece has been refinished in oxblood red. It features a crossbow shape with curved front legs and straight back legs, a drop-down panel revealing numerous compartments, a tabernacle door, and drawers made of natural wood; the front features three rows of five drawers each, the front legs are shell-shaped or snail-shaped. Featuring its original bronze ornamentation. An 18th-century Bordeaux piece from the Louis XV period, a classic model that is both solid and elegant, it is presented, refinished by the previous owners, in a "lovely" oxblood color. Highly decorative.
