Togo 2 seater sofa designed by French designer Michel Ducaroy for Ligne Roset, a masterpiece from the 70s. Re-covered with green corduroy fabric, it offers comfortable seating thanks to its all-foam design. Revolutionary when it was launched, it shook up the furniture codes of the 1970s. At a time when sofas were based on a wooden structure and exposed legs, Michel Ducaroy imagined a seat made entirely of foam and placed directly on the floor, this was the birth of the fireside chairs. A unique approach that offers exceptionally enveloping comfort. Inspired by a tube of toothpaste folded on itself, its bold design breaks with the standards of the time and contributes to making Togo a true icon of French design.
